Dr. Cher's work as both physician and scientist has given him a broad knowledge base about prostate cancer. He recognizes that cryotherapy is one of many valuable and appropriate options for treating prostate cancer. For many, it will be their best choice. "I expect that cryoablation should be able to destroy cancer equally as well as radiation or surgery. Cryo is a minimally invasive treatment option that is effective in treating cancer, has a quick recovery rate, and a low incidence of side effects."

Dr. Cher is a Professor and Chair for the Department of Urology at Wayne State University School of Medicine, where he holds the Donald J. Jaffar, M.D. Research Chair in Urology and is the Director of Urological Oncology. He is a member of the Genitourinary Oncology Team of The Barbara Ann Karmanos Cancer Institute. His research has received numerous accolades, including major grant awards. He is widely published and holds two U.S. patents related to the genetics of prostate cancer. Dr. Cher is certified by the American Board of Urology. He is an internationally recognized speaker and presenter. Just as important, he provides generous public service close to home, including prostate cancer screening programs.
